FORMAT: Essays must

- 1. Be typed and double spaced
- 2. Use 1 inch margins throughout the document
- 3. Be printed on 1 side only
- 4. Use Times New Roman in a 12 point font
- 5. Be between 1,000 and 1,500 words
- 6. Be e-mailed to Melba Broome, Director of the Learning Resources Division at mbroome@udc.edu

CONTENT: Essays must

- 1. Adhere to the theme:
 - "Perceptions of the UDC Library and Envisioned Transformations for 21st Century Services."
- 2. Follow directions for formatting
- 3. Show originality and focus
- 4. Reflect evidence of research
- 5. Contain proper citations (using the latest APA format) for any material that is not original in thought (SUBMISSIONS WILL BE CHECKED FOR PLAGERISM)
- 6. Avoid clichés
- 7. Use the active voice
- 8. Use a conclusion to capture the main points of the essay
- 9. Demonstrate quality in writing
